

#MakeAnECHO 2020-21

Welcome to ECHO 2020-21! As with almost everything, ECHO will look a little different this year as we navigate our top two priorities:

- 1) Musician/Instructor safety
- 2) Music education through performance

We have worked out a plan that covers both; here is how we are going to do it:

- -ECHO will be smaller: sections will be made up of less musicians per section WITH clear, physical barriers between each musician and/or 6-8 feet of social distancing. The goal of these barriers is to maintain assigned, individual space and safety at all times while being able to interact with instructors and other musicians. These barriers will allow ECHO to rehearse even in the event that schools are forced to go to fully remote instruction. Instructors will rotate, not musicians.
- -Masks/face shields will be worn by instructors (and encouraged for musicians).
- -Performances will be socially distanced.

While we are sure that challenges will arise, we are aware that our musicians need a safe outlet for interaction and the continuing development of their talents.

Also new this season:

The addition of winds and brass players! We will be adding 2 new instructors to musically round out our orchestral sound!

REGISTRATION:

We must require musicians to pre-register to be able to plan for musicians' safety. There are a LIMITED NUMBER of available spots this season that will be filled by a first come, first serve basis. Registration will take place through our website:
