Locked Out of Heaven

- Short articulations to match the lyrics
- Check your key signature! Low 1st finger Bb, F, and low 4th Eb touching your 3rd finger
- Dynamics:
 - o start **mezzo forte** through the verses
 - o crescendo to forte 2 measures before the chorus--- m. 32 & 33, 80 & 81
 - o each syncopated "Oh yeah yeah" begins **mf** section (m.3, 52 etc)
 - o crescendo to ff at the bridge--- m.98
 - decrescendo to f at m.113
 - o **mf** at m.132
- Shifting:
 - o 3rd position--- m.66-69, 112-117

I Just Wanna Dance With Somebody

- Don't drag! Be sure to stay on top of the beat, especially syncopated rhythms...
 so play short!
- Key change to A (3 sharps) @ m.96! High 3rd finger C# on E string in 3rd position.
 Stretch your 4th finger for the high E above that. You can use your harmonic to check the pitch
- Dynamics:
 - Intro(m.7, 81)- mf, Verse(m.17, 50, 89)- f, Chorus(m.32, 65, 96)- ff. Slowly decrescendo the last line.
- Only the verses should be played in 1st position. The intro and choruses must be in 3rd!

Circles

- Pay attention to staccato markings. Leave space between all other notes to imitate lyrics, but they do not need to be staccato.
- Check your key signature!! Low 2nd fingers need to be touching your first! Low 1st finger on E string
- Avoid playing open A and E as much as possible
- Dynamics
 - Intro(m. 2)- mf. Verse(m.18, 50- f. Crescendo to ff one measure before Chorus(m.32,64.) Drop to f at m. 81. Crescendo to ff at m. 88. Last measure f

Cake By the Ocean

- Leave space between eighth notes
- You are Joe Jonas! To imitate him, quarter and half notes can be longer, and add slides. On A string slide from 2nd finger E in 3rd position to 1st finger B- in m. 5 and every time after that in all the verses. Also slide from D to A in 3rd position on E string during chorus- "TALK to me"
- No open A or E string. If you don't like using your 4th finger, the entire song will be much easier played in 3rd position!
- After every eighth or sixteenth note rest, come in Up bow. All other measures should start Down. Use the lower half of your bow for the sections with sixteenth notes.
- Dynamics:
 - Verses- mf, Chorus- f

Treasure

- Leave space between the notes. Only notes marked staccato should be extra short.
- Don't play open A or E string. This is another song that can be played in 3rd position. Watch your intonation- make sure your F# and C# are high enough!
- Use the lower 3rd of your bow for the sixteenth note sections
- If you come in on the And of 4 or the and of 1, it's Up bow. Eighth notes on beat 4 start Down. Quarter notes on beat 4 start Up.
- Dynamics:
 - Verses- f, Chorus- ff

Since U Been Gone

- Space between notes, but not staccato. Decrescendo the half and whole notes
- When in 3rd position make sure your 3rd finger touches your 2nd on the E string
- Coming in on the And of a beat = Up bow **EXCEPT** at m. 30-32(and each time you have that phrase) which should start Down. Everything else starts Down.
- Dynamics:
 - Verses- mf, crescendo to f at "and all you'd ever/how come you never hear me say" (m. 18 and the next time). Crescendo to ff at "since you been gone", decrescendo to mf one measure before the next verse. Bridge- ff Slowly decrescendo the last 6 measures.

Sexy Back

- Everything staccato
- WATCH YOUR ACCIDENTALS!! High 3rd/Low 4th fingers for G# and D# **must** be high enough-- m.8 your 4th and high 3rd **touch**. In m.9 use low 4th **touching** your 3rd for D# and natural, followed by LOW 2nd finger.
- All measures starting on the and of a beat in the verse(beginning) and Bridge(m.17-23 and its repeat) start Up bow. Chorus(m.25-39 and its repeat) starts Down bow.
- Dynamics:
 - o Verse and Bridge- f, Chorus mf
